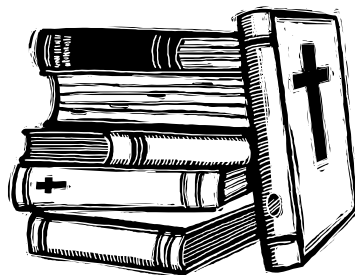

## FOOD PANTRY

Your food pantry is feeding more mouths than ever before.

- In November alone, there were 298 people served and total meals given were 2,682. This is a new record for a month.
- In 2010, the year's total was: People Served - 1,915; total meals given - 17,280.
- The totals for 2011's eleven months are: People served - 2,293; total meals given - 20,637.

This equates to 378 more people served and 3,402 meals given than in 2010.

December appears to be as busy as the rest of the year.
